

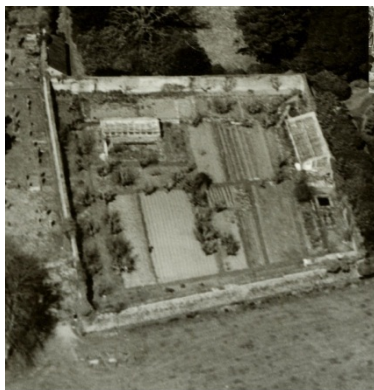

The Grade II Listed Walled Garden at the Bishop's Palace was once cared for by six gardeners and as this 1950s photo shows, the garden was in full production. Unfortunately, over the years it has become neglected. Recently the Tywi Gateway Trust was successful in gaining an HLF grant to conserve and revitalise the Bishop's Park and once the area had been cleared of vegetation a topographical survey revealed the remains of large glasshouses, heating and pathways. Artefacts have also been found including plant labels and other features associated with the long history of the garden. Dyfed Archaeological Trust has now been asked to conduct an excavation to determine whether there is yet more evidence to be found that would inform the restoration of this important place for a variety of horticultural and learning activities.

Yn wreiddiol roedd chwe garddwr yn gofalu am yr Ardd Furiog sy'n Radd II rhestredig ym Mharc yr Esgob ac fel y dengys y llun hwn o'r 1950au, roedd yr ardd yn hollol gynhyrchiol. Yn anffodus, dros y blynyddoedd, cafodd ei hesgeuluso. Yn ddiweddar llwyddodd Ymddiriedolaeth Porth Tywi i gael grant llawn Cronfa Treftadaeth y Loteri i gadw ac adfywio Parc yr Esgob ac unwaith i dyfiant yn yr ardal gael ei glirio dangosodd arolwg topograffig olion o dai gwydr mawr, system wresogi a llwybrau. Darganfuwyd creiriau hefyd gan gynnwys labeli planhigion a nodweddion eraill sy'n gysylltiedig â hanes hir yr ardd. Mae Ymddiriedolaeth Archaeolegol Dyfed wedi cael gwahoddiad i gloddio er mwyn gweld os oes hyd yn oed rhagor o dystiolaeth fyddai'n llywio adfer y lle pwysig hwn ar gyfer amrywiaeth o weithgareddau garddwriaeth a dysgu.

Byddwn yn gweithio ar y safle o Ddydd Llun 6ed tan Ddydd Gwener 17fed o Fawrth 2017, dros y penwythnosau ac yn ystod yr wythnos.
